All applications must be received by Friday, March 1, 2019. Please mail your applications early to meet this deadline. Walk-ins will not be accepted. You will receive a confirmation of receipt of your application via email.

#### **ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS**

All non-profit organizations are eligible to apply for Kaua'i Charity Walk grants including but not limited to, Corporations, Associations, Foundations and Schools. Proof of non-profit status is required. All applicants are encouraged to actively participate in the Kaua'i Charity Walk. Funding is based on participation and engagement.

#### USE OF FUNDS

- All grant funding must remain within the Kaua'i County and utilized to benefit the Kaua'i community. No funds are permitted to be used outside of Kaua'i County.
- Funds will **NOT** be granted for:
  - a. Programs outside of the County of Kaua'i.
  - b. The purchase of tangible real property or personal property.
  - c. Capital fund drives.
  - d. Payment of the accumulation of interest for the reduction of deficits or loans.
  - e. Salaries and benefits for existing staff
  - f. Travel funds (hotel, airfare, ground transportation, etc.)

#### **GRANT AMOUNTS**

- Grants will be considered based on an organization's community impact and may vary widely in scope and size
- Grant funds are to be used for specific projects.
- Grants from the Kaua'i Charity Walk are not a source of guaranteed continuous funding.
- Participation in the Kaua'i Charity Walk will affect a Grant Applicant's funding.

#### ADMINISTRATION/APPLICATION PROCESS

- Please read all materials carefully and contact Morgan Lopez at morgan@hltakauai.org with any questions before submitting application.
- All applications MUST BE TYPED.
- Any incomplete applications will not be considered for funding.
- Complete Grant Application and submit with items outlined in the Attachment section of the application form.
- The Allocations Committee reserves the right to award or deny any Kaua'i Charity Walk Grant Application and may request modifications or additions to the application at any time.
- All organizations seeking funds must submit a new application each year.
- All materials submitted will NOT be returned.
- Late Application will NOT be accepted.
